

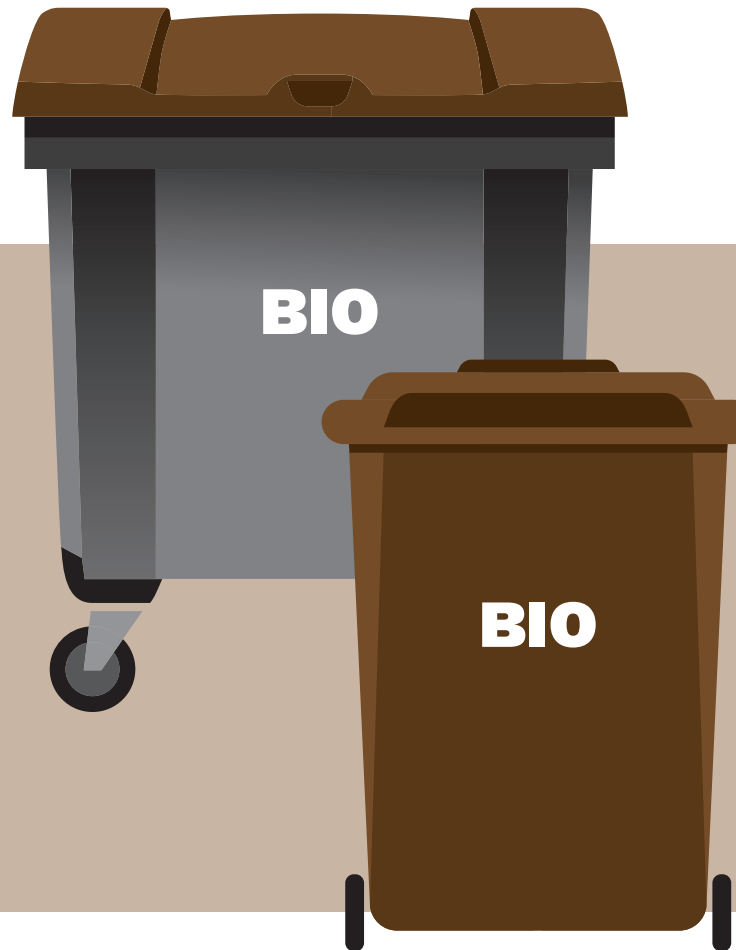
TIPS ON HOW TO SORT BIO-WASTE PROPERLY



WHAT BELONGS IN THE BROWN BIO-WASTE BIN

The brown bio-waste bin is intended for biodegradable plant-based waste from households. This includes:

- Kitchen scraps like peels, cores, pits, fruit and vegetable trimmings
- Houseplants and soil from flower pots
- Wood charcoal ash
- Coffee grounds



WHAT DOES NOT BELONG IN THE BROWN BIO-WASTE BIN

- Animal remains such as meat, fats, bones, and dairy products (butter, yogurt, cheese)
- Frying oils
- Textiles
- Cigarettes
- Ashes (other than wood charcoal)
- Dead animals, Animal excrements
- Plastics, glass, and mixed municipal waste

IMPORTANT NOTE: IT IS ESSENTIAL TO DISPOSE OF BIO-WASTE WITHOUT BAGS, EVEN IF THEY ARE COMPOSTABLE.

WHY PROPER BIO-WASTE SORTING MATTERS: CORRECTLY SORTED BIO-WASTE CONTRIBUTES TO THE PRODUCTION OF HIGH-QUALITY COMPOST, WHICH IS USED, FOR EXAMPLE, IN MAINTAINING THE GREENERY OF THE CITY OF BRNO.
